From Saturday-Wednesday it operates from 05:50 am in the morning till 00:00 am, midnight. On Thursdays it runs for a slightly longer time period from 05:50 am in the morning, till 01:00 am the next day. Fridays offer 12- hour service from 13:00 pm in the afternoon, till 01:00 am the next day. The frequency of the trains differ with the lines. The average distance between two stations is just 1.5 km. The Red Line has a headway of about 3:45 minutes during peak hours, and 7 minutes during off-peak hours. Dubai Metro Fares, Tickets and Cards The metro uses Nol cards and Nol tickets for travelling. The Nol silver card is valid for 5 years and holds up to AED 500 worth of credit. It's suited for frequent travelers. Nol Gold card's validity and credit limit is same as silver card, however, with a gold card, riders can travel on Gold class cabins on the metro. Wayang force. There's a Nol Blue card for frequent travelers that is personalized. With this card, students and senior citizens can avail a discount of 50%. The system uses a Nol Red ticket for occasional use. It's a paper ticket that can be purchased for AED 2 and remains valid for 90 days. The ticket is prepaid based on the number of zones travelled. A one day permit is also available that can be purchased for 14 AED. The metro journey falls in 4 tiers. Tier 0 equals to a distance of 3 km or less. A regular ticket can be purchased for AED 1.80. For seniors and students travelling in regular class, it's available for AED 0.90. For Gold class, it costs AED 3.60. Tier 1 starts and ends in the same zone. Regular class costs AED 2.30. For students and seniors, it costs AED 1.50. For Gold class, it costs AED 4.60. Tier 2 starts in one zone and ends in a neighboring zone. Regular class costs AED 4.10. For seniors and students, it costs AED 2.05. For Gold class, it costs AED 8.20. Tier 3 exceeds two zones. Regular ticket is available for AED 5.80. Seniors and Students can avail it for AED 2.90. A few of the stations did not open straight away. However, as of 1 March 2014 all of the stations were fully open on both the green and red lines and in 2021 the Expo 2020 extension was also fully opened. Both the green and the red lines will likely be extended further in the future to add to the 18 green line stations and the 35 red line station currently being used. About the City Of Dubai Dubai is the largest city in the UAE and the capital of the Emirate of Dubai. It is home to about 90% of the emirate's population. As of 2017, Dubai had approximately 2.8 million people and a daytime population of about 4 million people. The city is a central global transportation hub, a major shopping center, and a center for regional trade. Dubai's growth was accelerated by oil revenue. Today, the city's economy relies on revenues from tourism, business, real estate, aviation, and financial service. The first written mention of Dubai as a city is found in the geographer Abu Abdullah al-(1014–1094) Bakri's "Book of Geography," published in 1095. When it was recognized as a hub of commerce and pearling in the Middle Ages, it was a significant port city. The sheiks who governed Dubai struck a contract with the British in 1892, according to which the United Kingdom committed to "defend" Dubai from the Ottoman Empire for some time. During the Great Depression of the 1930s, Dubai's pearl business came to a grinding halt. The United Arab Emirates was formed in 1971 when Dubai combined with six other emirates to establish the United Arab Emirates. Foreign investors were forced to evacuate Dubai during the first Gulf War in 1990 due to the military and political unrest in the region. In addition to fossil resources, Dubai's economy is now diversified, relying on real estate and construction, transportation exports, and financial services, among other things, to support itself. Geography and Landscape of Dubai Dubai is on the coast of the Persian Gulf within the Arabian Desert. The urban area around the city is approximately 3,885 square miles. Much of the city's landscape has sandy desert patterns. The sand is made up of crushed shells and corals. The eastern portion of the town consists of coastal plains known as sabkha. The Western Hajar Mountains run along the Dubai-Oman border. The Dubai Creek runs through the city in a northeast-southwest direction. The locality Deira is formed in the eastern part of the city, with Dubai International Airport as the main feature of the locality. The city site, Layout and Land Expansion in Dubai Dubai is located in the southern part the Persian Gulf, straddling a natural inlet known as Dubai Creek. Because the early city's economy was based on fishing, pearl diving, and marine trade, the area served as Dubai's geographic center for more than a century. Those who have lived in Dubai for a long time may recognize the buildings that line the creek, most of which date back to the 1960s and are rarely more than two floors high. Several much older structures have been renovated in the Bastakiyyah area, located on the western side of the creek. The new city center comprises a stretch of towers along Sheikh Zayed Road in Abu Dhabi. The Dubai International Financial Centre, which is housed in a futuristic arch-shaped building, and the Burj Khalifa, which was the world's tallest building at the time of its official opening in 2010 and was named after the president of the United Arab Emirates and emir of Abu Dhabi, Khalifa ibn Zayed Al Nahyan, are both located close to Sheikh Zayed Road. With roughly 3.33 million residents as of September 2019, the Emirate of Dubai is the second most populous of the seven United Arab Emirates and the second biggest in terms of land area. Dubai's cityscape is constantly shifting and evolving due to the city's ongoing desire to build bigger and better structures than before. If there existed a Palm Island, Nakheel imagined the World Island as a possible replacement. The Burj Khalifa was made, and the Burj Al Arab was rendered obsolete. Dubai is constantly competing with itself, attempting to draw travelers to a world of delights reminiscent of a dream. Even though it adheres to its traditional Islamic traditions to the letter, it makes room for other religions, a unique characteristic in the conservative Arab world. UAE's cosmopolitan city, Dubai, has developed as a worldwide melting pot and a commercial and cultural center, growing gradually. The metropolitan region around the city encompasses over 1,500 square miles (3,885 square kilometers), with the city proper being approximately 15.5 square miles (25 square kilometers) (35 sq km). In addition to the development of artificial islands in the gulf, which will be known as Marsa Al Arab, as well as some construction in the desert areas, "The newest manufactured islands, completed in 2017, will cover 4 million square feet (14 square miles, 37 square kilometers) and extend the city's shoreline by 1.5 miles (2.4 kilometers). These new artificial islands do not represent the first time that artificial islands have been added to the city's shoreline. Three hundred private islands (dubbed "The World") were first constructed beginning in 2003 and sold to developers or affluent individuals to build private luxury residences (or many mansions on a single island) and resorts. Even though the majority of the 300 islands in the vicinity are undeveloped, construction in the area known as The Heart of Europe resumed in 2016 after having been suspended in 2008 during the global recession. Climate in Dubai In common with the rest of the Persian Gulf coastline, Dubai enjoys a hot temperature. Humidity is highest during the summer months and lowest during the rest of the year, except the winter months. The coldest winter month is often January, with lows of approximately 15 degrees Celsius (49 degrees Fahrenheit). The warmest summer month is typically July, with highs of more than 40 degrees Celsius (104 degrees Fahrenheit). People in Dubai A hot climate prevails throughout Dubai, as much of the Persian Gulf shoreline. High humidity levels are seen during the summer months, with only moderate levels throughout the remainder of the year. A typical January low temperature of 15 degrees Celsius (49 degrees Fahrenheit) is recorded, while the warmest summer month is July, with highs of 40 degrees Celsius (104 degrees Fahrenheit).
